Dear Ms. Kelly:

On August 27 - 28, 2013, the California Environmental Protection Agency (CalEPA), the Department of Toxic Substances Control, the California Office of Emergency Services, and the State Water Resources Control Board conducted a Unified Program evaluation of the Colusa County Department of Environmental Health Certified Unified Program Agency (CUPA). The evaluation comprised of an in-office review of regulated facility files and records and oversight inspections.

Upon closing of the evaluation, a final Summary of Findings was issued to the CUPA, identifying program deficiencies and providing corrective actions with timeframes for correction. Program observations, recommendations, and examples of outstanding implementation were also noted.

CalEPA has received the required Deficiency Progress Reports from the CUPA to demonstrate progress towards correction of deficiencies identified in the Summary of Findings. Upon review of the submitted Deficiency Progress Reports, the following deficiencies remain and are considered in the process of being corrected:

1. The CUPA is not regulating farms under the business plan program, nor exempting them from the provisions from the provisions plan program.

CalEPA appreciates the corrective actions the CUPA is taking. These remaining deficiencies will be incorporated into the upcoming evaluation scheduled to begin July 15, 2015.

Based upon review and completion of the evaluation, the implementation and performance of the Unified Program by the CUPA will remain as satisfactory with improvements needed, until the remaining deficiencies are corrected or until the conclusion of the upcoming evaluation.
