The Healdsburg/Sebastopol Joint Power Authority (JPA) Certified Unified Program Agency (CUPA) has been selected for an evaluation in **2017**. The evaluation process has changed since the last evaluation took place.

  - o public participation,
  - o records maintenance,
  - o information request response,
  - o business plan information forwarding,
  - o permitting,
  - financial management (includes the single fee system, fee accountability program, and surcharge collection and reimbursement program),
  - o fee dispute resolution,
  - o data management.

  - APSA Inspector Training Certificates
  - Ongoing training Documentation (past 3 years)
- 2-3 recently closed formal enforcement case files (within the last 2 years)
- CUPA Organization Chart

The CalEPA Team Lead will follow up with you, and provide information on how to access the SFTP site.
