Dear Mr. Joel Martens:

The performance evaluation of the Tulare County Environmental Health Certified Unified Program Agency (CUPA) is scheduled to occur beginning December, 2017, through April, 2018. The CUPA performance evaluation process has changed since the last CUPA evaluation took place.

To facilitate the new remote performance evaluation process, the CUPA must electronically submit documentation requested as listed within the enclosures to the California Environmental Protection Agency (CalEPA) by February 27, 2018. Such requested documentation includes administrative and standard operating procedures, documents specific to program elements and information from select facility files representative of the regulated facilities from each of the program elements. The enclosures list the specific facility file information to be provided electronically from each of the facility files requested (Enclosure 2).

A Secure File Transfer Protocol (SFTP) site has been made available by CalEPA to enable the CUPA to electronically provide the information requested above. The CalEPA Team Lead, Marc Lorentzen will provide information on how to access the SFTP site.
