The performance evaluation of the City of El Segundo Fire Department Environmental Safety Certified Unified Program Agency (CUPA) is scheduled to occur beginning January, 2018, through May, 2018. The CUPA evaluation process has changed since the last CUPA evaluation took place.

To facilitate the new remote evaluation process, the CUPA must electronically submit documentation requested in Enclosures 1 and 2 to the California Environmental Protection Agency (CalEPA) by **March 20, 2018**.

A Secure File Transfer Protocol (SFTP) site has been made available by CalEPA to enable the CUPA to electronically provide the information requested above. The CalEPA Team Lead, Marc Lorentzen will provide information on how to access the SFTP site.
