Narrative description of the violations observed

Illegal marijuana growing operation was the subject of a law enforcement search warrant. During the warrant execution, it was determined that the site had hazardous substances, ASTs and household hazardous wastes. Humboldt CUPA was called to investigate. Evidence collected at the site resulted in an enforcement case against the operator. The case was delayed for several years due to evasion by the operator. In November, 2014, Humboldt CUPA conducted a settlement meeting with the operator, in advance of an impending ALJ hearing. The operator settled with Humboldt CUPA, agreeing to conduct cleanup of the subject property and payment of penalties.

1. The operator agreed to cleanup the property, utilizing an engineering consultant, by November 3, 2016.
2. The operator agreed to pay penalties of \$75,000.00 over a period of four years. If the site is completely cleaned up by the 11/3/16 date, \$20,000.00 of the penalties will be waived. Agency costs were \$5,224.00 and will be amortized over the four years of payments.
